ADD PRAISE!

Speak out loud. Let God hear your voice.

Isaiah 25:1 "O LORD, thou art my God; I will exalt thee, I will praise thy name; for thou hast done wonderful things; thy counsels of old are faithfulness and truth."

Psalms 18:46 "The LORD liveth; and blessed be my rock; and let the God of my salvation be exalted."

PUT ON THE WHOLE ARMOUR OF GOD

Ephesians 6:10-18

Why should I do this?

"Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might. Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places. Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand."

How do I do this?

Speak out loud the scripture beginning with "It is written..." and then personalize it: "In Jesus' name I..."

* "Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness;"

* "And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace;"

* "Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked."

* "And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God."

"Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints;"

Romans 10:17 "So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God."

**Read the Bible (God's Word) every day

OVERCOMING THE POWERS OF DARKNESS

Speak God's Word then claim it out loud.

Revelations 12:11 "And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death." *I overcome the devil by the blood of the Lamb and the word of my testimony.*

Ephesians 1:7 "In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace."

Psalms 107:2 "Let the redeemed of the LORD say so, whom he hath redeemed from the hand of the enemy;" *Through the blood of Jesus, I am redeemed out of the hand of the enemy.*

I John 1:7 "If we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin." *Through the blood of Jesus, all my sins are forgiven and continually.*

Romans 5:9 "Much more then, being now justified by his blood, we shall be saved from wrath through him."

II Corinthians 5:21 "For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him."

Hebrews 13:12 "Wherefore Jesus also, that he might sanctify the people with his own blood, suffered without the gate." *Through the blood of Jesus, I am justified, made righteous, and sanctified, daily!*

I Corinthians 3:16 "Know ye not that ye are the temple of God, and that the Spirit of God dwelleth in you?"

Psalms 81:9 "There shall no strange god be in thee;"

II Corinthians 6:14 "...for what communion hath light with darkness?"

SHIELD OF FAITH

"It is written..." "Thank you, God..."

James 5:15 "And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up;"

Romans 8:11 "...he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you." (*"Personalize the pronouns such as, 'your' becomes 'my', and 'you' becomes 'me'. After healing petition, place each verse in past tense."*)

Psalms 5:12 "For thou, LORD, wilt bless the righteous; with favour wilt thou compass him as with a shield."

Romans 8:2 "For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death."

John 8:36 "If the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed."

I John 4:4 "Ye are of God...greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world."

I John 3:8 "For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that he might destroy the works of the devil."

John 16:23 "Verily, verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall ask the Father in my name, he will give it to you."

Psalms 84:11b "...no good thing will he withhold from them that walk uprightly."

BINDING AND LOOSING

"It is written..."

Matthew 16:19 "...whatsoever thou shalt bind on earth shall be bound in heaven; and whatsoever thou shalt loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven."

II Corinthians 10:4-5 "For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war after the flesh; (For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;) casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;"

"In the Name of Jesus, begin to bind all the powers of darkness which come against you and loose all the powers of heaven which are at your disposal. To bind is to bind something up so it cannot move. To loose is to turn something loose. So bind the evil and loose the opposite—the greater powers of God: His fruits, His gifts, His ministering spirits, etc. In prayer, think of opposites, such as: pain vs. peace; fear vs. faith; confusion vs. clarity of mind, etc."

DAILY BREAKING OF CURSES

Galatians 3:13-14 "Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, 'Cursed is everyone that hangeth on a tree'. That the blessing of Abraham might come on the Gentiles through Jesus Christ; that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith."

Deuteronomy 28:7 "The LORD shall cause thine enemies that rise up against thee to be smitten before thy face: they shall come out against thee one way, and flee before thee seven ways."

In Jesus' Name: render all curses placed upon you to be null, void, and inoperative; cancel all of Satan's assignments, manipulations, and holding tactics; and command Satan to cease all operations against you. Next, bind in heaven and earth in Jesus' Name the power of all curses, breaking them to pieces, and sending them back to where they came from."

"Then, loose in Jesus' Name all that you need, such as faith without wavering, forgiveness for others and for yourself, health, guidance, etc."

INTERCESSION

I Timothy 2:1-6 "I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men; For kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty. For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Saviour; Who will have all men to be saved, and to come unto the knowledge of the truth. For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus; Who gave himself a ransom for all, to be testified in due time."

REQUEST FOR DIVINE PROTECTION AND AID

"Father God, in Jesus' Name, I ask for divine protection and the aid of Your angels & ministering spirits, for it is written:"

Psalms 34:7 "The angel of the LORD encampeth round about them that fear him, and delivereth them."

Hebrews 1:14 "Are they not all ministering spirits, sent forth to minister for them who shall be heirs of salvation?"

THANKSGIVING

Colossians 3:17 "And whatsoever ye do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God and the Father by him."

I Chronicles 16:34 "Oh give thanks unto the LORD for he is good, for his mercy endureth forever."
